- 1. Status: Independent Constitutional Agency
 - The 5th constitutional agency
 - EC as a part of executive branch (1948)
 - → reestablished as a constitutional body (1963)

III. NEC and Measures for Independence

- 1. Status: Independent Constitutional Agency
- Composition
 - : check & balance among legislature, executive, and judicial branches
 - 3 members appointed by the President
 - 3 members selected by the National Assembly
 - 3 members designated by the Supreme Court

III. NEC and Measures for Independence

1. Status: Independent Constitutional Agency

- Independence and impartiality of election commissioners:
 prevent party affiliation and intervention in politics
- Chairperson (a Supreme Court justice) elected by commissioners
- Standing commissioner (minister level) serves full-time and supervises the secretariat

Ⅲ. NEC and Measures for Independence

2. Composition: Nationwide Permanent Body

- NEC, 16 Si/Do ECs, 251 Gu/Si/Gun ECs
- Secretariat of NEC: secretary general (minister level), deputy secretary general, 2 offices, 7 bureaus, 25 divisions
- Commissioners with 6 years of term of office vs. secretariat officials under merit system
- Occupational expertise and independence of the secretariat from commissioners

III. NEC and Measures for Independence

3. Powers and Responsibilities of NEC

- · Fair management of elections
 - public elections
 - private elections : elections for schools, apartment houses, district-redevelopment cooperatives, etc.
- · Political parties and funds affairs
- Power to enforce and investigate election law/ political fund law violations
- · Democratic civic/political education
