


Women currently play different roles in the political and electoral life:

#### Women in EMBs..






Out of 24 independent EMBs across Europe, 7 are chaired by women.



## WHAT TO DO?



Nancy Pelosi and 100 more women all over the world's letter to Facebook...

- Quick removal of posts that threaten candidates with physical violence, sexual violence or death, and that glorify, incite or praise violence against women; disable the relevant accounts, and refer offenders to law enforcement.
- Eliminate malicious hate speech targeting women, including violent, objectifying or dehumanizing speech, statements of inferiority, and derogatory sexual terms;
- Remove accounts that repeatedly violate terms of service by threatening, harassing or doxing or that use false identities to attack women leaders and candidates; and
- *Remove manipulated images or videos misrepresenting women public figures.*
- Stop the amplification of gendered disinformation on your platform. Much of the most hateful content directed at women on Facebook is amplified by your algorithms which reward extreme and dangerous points of view with greater reach and visibility creating a fertile breeding ground for bias to grow.

AN EFFECTIVE COMMUNICATION PLAN DEVELOPED BY ELECTORAL MANAGEMENT BODIES SHOULD:

Inform and educate the citizens

Build and maintain trust and credibility


Position the EMB as the main source of information and expertise on everything related to elections
