

Results of Voter Education Campaign

- 98 percent of the ballots cast were voted by mail (either returned by mail or dropped off in person at a ballot drop-off location).
- Only 2 percent of the ballots were cast in person, either during the 14-day early voting period or on Election Day.
- Turnout was 480,855 (29.5 percent of active registered voters).
 - Most ballots ever cast for a primary election in Nevada.
 - As a percent of active registered voters, highest primary election turnout since 2010.
 - As a percent of active registered voters, highest presidential election year primary election turnout since 1996.










Two-thirds of voters back vote-by-mail in November 2020

All ballots are forwarded to their respective counties for processing.












III. Ballot Drop-Off During Early Voting


IV. Ballot Drop-Off at Election Day Polling Places










