SLOVENE LOCAL ELECTIONS

- ELECTIONS AND REFERENDUM CAMPAIGN ACT (LAST AMENDMENTS IN 2013) + 11 OTHER CONNECTED ACTS
- MAIN FEATURES:
- ü 30 DAY CAMPAIGN
- **Ü** SPENDING CAP (PER CAPITA)
- **U OBLIGATORY FINANCIAL REPORTING (4 MONTHS AFTER ELECTIONS)**
- **Ü RULES ON HOW TO MARK CERTAIN CAMPAIGN MATERIAL**
- ü **HIGH PENALTIES**
- **Ü PROHIBITION OF FINANCING FROM LEGAL ENTITIES**



TRANSPARENCY OF ELECTIONS AND ELECTORAL INTEGRITY

- 3 MAIN SUPERVISORY BODIES: INSPECTORATE FOR INTERNAL AFFAIRS, COURT OF AUDIT, INSPECTORATE FOR CULTURE AND MEDIA
- 212 MUNICIPALITIES, 5 MONITORED
- MORE THAN HALF NON-PARTY MAYORS





- INADEQUATE OR FALSE LABELLING OF MATERIALS
- DAMAGING OF RIVAL MATERIALS
- ABUSE OF POWER FOR ELECTION PURPOSES

- **NEW LEGISLATION SINCE 2013**
- 1 OUT OF 10 BILLBOARDS CORRECTLY LABELED
- SYSTEMATIC VIOLATIONS OF LEGISLATIVE FRAMEWORK
- PENALTIES AND ENFORCEMENT?



OBSERVATIONS AND PROBLEMATIC AREAS SANCTIONS (CASE STUDY IN 2014)

101 VIOLATIONS REPORTED

ONLY ONE FINE ISSUED

ONLY ONE AUDIT OF A CAMPAIGN




OBSERVATIONS AND PROBLEMATIC AREAS INVESTMENTS

- SLOVENE MUNICIPALITIES SPEND OVER 2 BILLION EUROS PER YEAR
- EXPENDITURE FOR INVESTMENTS HIGHER IN ELECTION YEARS
- CONFIRMED TREND OF POLITICALLY MOTIVATED INVESTMENTS IN ELECTORAL YEAR IN MUNICIPALITIES

MUNICIPAL BUDGETS: 2008 – 2018



- TREND OF RISING INVESTMENTS IN INFRASTRUCTURE IN ELECTORAL YEARS (5 BIGGEST MUNICIPALITIES)
- TEMPORARY RISE OF GDP, NO INDICATION OF RISE OF COSTS OF CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS
- LACK OF EVALUATION OF THIS PHENOMENOM
 - EFFECT ON REELECTION FAIR PARTICIPATION AND USE OF PUBLIC FUNDS?
 - CORRUPTION RISKS?
 - RATIONAL USE OF FUNDS?






• MEDIA TEND TO REPLICATE OFFICIAL SOURCES, LITTLE CRITICAL REPORTING

MAYORS ABUSING POWER TO GAIN MEDIA ATTENTION

 LOCAL MEDIA CONTROLLED BY MUNICIPALITIES HIGHLY PROBLEMATIC



















OBSERVATIONS AND PROBLEMATIC AREAS FINANCIAL REPORTING

- REPORTING OF INELIGIBLE COSTS
- FAILING TO REPORT COSTS, INADEQUATE REPORTING
- DEBT
- LACK OF IMMEDIATE TRANSPARENCY



RECCOMENDATIONS

- CONNECTIONS WITH PARTY FINANCING 75,1 % OF FUNDS OF POLITICAL PARTIES FROM PUBLIC FUNDS (2014) – FOI?
- NEED FOR IMMEDIATE, PROACTIVE AND REAL TIME TRANSPARENCY
- LACK OF EFFICIENT CONTROL LEGISLATURE, FINANCIAL AND STAFF RESTRICTIONS AND/OR LACK OF AWARENESS (ESPECIALLY LOCAL ELECTIONS)
- INCREASING THE ROLE OF CIVIL SOCIETY? UNTAPPED POTENTIAL AND RESOURCES
- DEFINING THE ISSUE AREA OF LOCAL MEDIA
- DEFINING THE ISSUE AREA OF DEBTS AND ELECTIONS CAMPAIGNS
- BANNING THE CONTRIBUTIONS IN CASH.
- REMUNERATION OF ELECTION COSTS SHOULD BE TIED TO SUCCESSFUL REPORTING OF ELECTION CAMPAIGN COSTS
